Buckle Kids Right: Know the Stages

1. Rear-facing Birth until age 2-4*



3. Booster Seats
After outgrowing forward-facing seat and until seat belts fit properly***



2. Forward-facing
After outgrowing rear-facing seat until at least age 5**



4. Seat BeltsWhen they fit properly and throughout life***



Always properly buckle children aged 12 and under in the back seat!

^{***}Proper seat belt fit usually occurs around 4 feet 9 inches tall and age 9-12. Seat belts fit properly when the lap belt lays across upper thighs (not the stomach) and the shoulder belt lays across the chest (not the neck).



^{*}As long as possible, until they reach the maximum weight or height limit of their rear-facing car seat.

^{**}Until they reach the maximum weight or height limit of their forward-facing car seat.
